#### 1. Introduction

Elias Motsoaledi Local Municipality requests the proposals from experienced service providers for supply and erect of precast concrete palisade for fencing of Ntwane cemetery.

#### 2. Executive summary

Elias Motsoaledi Local Municipality in the 2021/2022 financial year budget has prioritized capital projects. Amongst other projects that were prioritized is the project that is serving on this Bid document classified as follows:

Appointment of contractor for fencing of Ntwane Cemetery (Ward 10)

#### 2.1 Labour intensive based construction

Municipality expect the successful bidder to apply innovations on maximizing applications of labour intensive methods without compromising quality standard of the work. The municipality has estimated sufficient maximization of local labour components that were identified are but not limited to: -

- Site clearance
- Supply, digging and erection of 25mpa concrete palisade fence
- 25mpa concrete palisade fencing 2.4m height
- Installation of 1m (meter) width and 2m high pedestrian gate

#### 2.2 Quality control and quality Assurance

The prospective service provider must show his/ her capabilities for offering to render for the service. The project team must be clearly indicated designation for each member of the team. The concrete palisade must comply with SANS/SABS standard.

#### 2.3 Health and Safety Requirements

The successful bidder must take into account all aspects of the occupational Health and Safety Act which has been enacted to provide for Health and Safety of person in connection with the use of tools, equipment, plant and machinery, the protection of persons against hazard to health and safety arising out or in connection with the activities of persons at work, to establish an advisory council for occupational health and safety and to provide for matters connected therewith. However, the contractor, shall still be accountable for the compliance and adherence to the OHS Act.

A clear itemized bill of quantity for the works is part of the document and service providers are requested to provide rates to the bill outlined

A clear preliminary program for the works must be indicated. This program shall include all activities of the project


