1. Introduction

Elias Motsoaledi Local Municipality requests the proposal from experienced service providers for INSTALL AND COMMISSION TRAFFIC LIGHTS AT VAN RIEBECK AND NOORD LAAN.

2. Executive summary

Elias Motsoaledi Local Municipality in the 2021/2022 financial year budget has prioritized that the traffic lights must meet required standards. There is a stop street on the main road in between two functioning traffic light intersections. The backlog created by the stop street is undoing the flow of traffic created before and after by the traffic lights. The green light from Van Riebeeck and Tautes Street create traffic to the stop street and hence to replace with traffic light. A buildup of traffic congestion from the preceding intersection will be eliminated.

Amongst other projects that were prioritized is the project that is serving on this Bid document classified as follows:

Appointment of Service Provider for the INSTALL AND COMMISSION TRAFFIC LIGHTS AT VAN RIEBECK AND NOORD LAAN

2.1 Quality control and quality Assurance

The prospective service provider must show his/ her capabilities for offering to render for the service. SANS/SABS standard to be adhered to at all Cost.

2.2 Health and Safety Requirements

The successful bidder must take into account all aspects of the occupational Health and Safety Act which has been enacted to provide for Health and Safety of person in connection with the use of tools, equipment, plant and machinery, the protection of persons against hazard to health and safety arising out or in connection with the activities of persons at work, to establish an advisory council for occupational health and safety and to provide for matters connected therewith. However, the contractor, shall still be accountable for the compliance and adherence to the OHS Act.

2.3 Estimated project cost

A clear itemized bill of quantity for the Supply is part of the document and service providers are requested to provide rates.

2.4 SCOPE OF WORK

- **2.4.1.** Install and Commission a new 4 Phase traffic intersection to replace the Stop street.
- 2.4.2. Synchronize the existing traffic lights with the new through the use of GPS Clock and Lunar Controllers.
- 2.4.3 Create the 'Green Wave ' down the main road during peak periods including holidays. Using: Van Riebeeck Tautes, Van Riebeeck Voortrekker and Van Riebeeck, Noord Laan Lunar Controllers.
- 2.4.4 Trench and lay new Sleeve duct for the cabling.
