It is a privilege to us today to be joined by the a group distinguished men and women of business leaders from across the municipality especially in Groblersdal for the Mayoral Business Roundtable, an initiative aimed at identifying strategies that would enable us to forge partnerships of mutual beneficiation. It is an obligation bestowed on us to create an enabling environment through policies and provision of infrastructure network to assist your businesses to thrive. Elias Motsoaledi Local Municipality is not these building because these building can become a building of another entity. Elias Motsoaledi local Municipality is but a combination of Municipal Council consisting of Councillors, Administration and communities consisting of all Stakeholders inclusive of yourselves as Business people.

The contributions of Businesses owned by yourselves is immense and affect positively to the social upliftment of our communities. You have employed multitudes of our people and enabled them to feed their families. Again, you are continuously paying property rates, which enables the municipality to fulfil some of its service delivery mandate and obligation and reduce the municipality's reliance on Grants.

Our effort to expand settlement capacity of Groblersdal Town is realizable as we are currently in the process of mobilizing resources for installation of infrastructure services for the proposed township at the then game farm.

Elias Motsoaledi Local Municipality has made submission to NERSA and all relevant authorities in an attempt to increase its revenue base by acquiring Electricity distribution licenses for the following areas: Game Farm, Twin City Mall, Groblersdal and, MapochGrond in ward 30.

The Municipality is planning to upgrade the current Groblersdal substation from 20MVA to 40MVA, as it will soon reach its full capacity, which will otherwise have a positive impact on the economic growth of the municipality.

Programme director as I conclude allow me to indicate projects that will be implemented and funded internally by our collection revenue: Energy efficiency and Demand site management, Installation of electrical meters in Groblersdal, Upgrading of Groblersdal substation and Groblersdal Roads and Streets.

The Chief Financial Officer will brief you on the financial position of the municipality, our budget and revenue collection enhancement strategies.

I hope that we will constantly meet and have roundtable discussions about issues that affect our people, generate ideas and help each other realise our 2030 vision.
