TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR

PROPOSED REZONING & SUBDIVISION OF ERF 832, GROBLERSDAL EXTENSION 15 RE-ADVERT.

1. Introduction.

Elias Motsoaledi local Municipality intends appointing a service provider for the Proposed Rezoning & Subdivision of Erf 832, Groblersdal Extension 15.

2. Background.

The Development Planning and Local economic Development Directorate of Elias Motsoaledi Local Municipality has prioritized the Rezoning and Subdivision of Erf 832, Groblersdal Extension 15; in order to promote alignment in terms of what is happening on the ground and allocated land uses as per the Groblersdal Town Planning Scheme (2006). The latter undertaking is prioritized for 2020/2021 year of finances.

3. Purpose.

The purpose of this document is to set out terms of reference on which professional teams should base their tender for delivering a professional service for the Elias Motsoaledi Local Municipality. The tender should clearly adopt the approach to be adopted, proposed methodology, relevant experience, time frame, program and associated budget and the proposed team members.

4. Objectives.

The main objective is to comply with the current legislative frameworks within the Elias Motsoaledi Local Municipality such as the EMLM Spatial Development Framework (2018), the Groblersdal Precinct Plan (2010) and EMLM SPLUM By-Law (2016), which controls land use management.

5. SCOPE OF WORK.

The scope of the assignment consists of the following:

- Survey of the existing structures on erf 832, Groblersdal Extension 15 that is currently being used for burial, administration and office space.
- Lodge a rezoning and subdivision application to the relevant authority in terms of applicable legislation.
- Secure approval of the rezoning and sub-division application from relevant authority.
- Pegging of erven.
- Secure approval of the subdivision diagram with the surveyor general's office.
- Secure registration of erven with the deeds office.

5.1. List of Activities.

7. PROJECT DURATION.
