1. INTRODUCTION

The Elias Motsoaledi Local Municipality (EMLM) advertised on the month of August 2016 in the Newspaper for Request for Quotations from Service providers to Supply and Deliver 25kg Cold Mix Asphalt Bags, Continuous graded hot asphalt and Road marking paints for a period of 36 months (3 years) on as and when required.

2. SCOPE OF THE WORKS

The Cold Mix Asphalt, Continuous graded hot asphalt and the Road Marking paints should comply with the relevant SABS standards and the following requirements:

Cold Mix Asphalt

- o The Premix should be a 25kg bag of Cold Mix Asphalt
- Apply in any weather condition
- Be easy to apply with no tack coat required
- Take traffic immediately without defects
- Allowable storage of 12 months without drying out
- o The supply will be informed in writing when the cold mix is required
- o The supply time for the delivery should be within 7 working days from the date of the request.

Hot Asphalt

Continuous graded hot asphalt, to be delivered on site hot

Road Marking Paints

- The road marking paints required is 5\ell and 20\ell (white, yellow, red and black) and also includes the following:
- o **Performance-** Excellent Scuff Resistance; High-Build Finish and Withstands Repeated Washing
- Product information
 - Typical Use-Suitable for exterior use.
 - Pack Size-5 Litre and 20 Litre
 - Colour Range-White, black, red & Yellow.
- Film Properties
- o Chemical Resistance: Not recommended where spillage of petrol or solvents is likely.
