1. INTRODUCTION

The Elias Motsoaledi Local Municipality is pursuant of a Service Provider that can supply, install and maintain License Plate Recognition (LPR) cameras and public space surveillance systems with Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) cameras for demarcated areas over a fixed 36-month full maintenance lease agreement with a fully functional back office and security cleared personnel. As such, your organization is hereby offered the opportunity to submit a proposal for the solution. The solution is divided into four (4) components as detailed below and must be quoted per unit. Submissions of proposals for the four (4) components noted below are required to be separated into its own submission and quoted per unit. NOTE MUST BE TAKEN THAT THE SUBMISSION IS FOR THE SUPPLY, INSTALLATION AND FULL MAINTENANCE OF ALL EQUIPMENT FOR A 36 MONTH LEASE PERIOD WITH A FULLY FUNCTIONAL BACK OFFICE AND SECURITY CLEARED PERSONNEL.

The four (4) components are as follows:

A. CCTV Cameras

- a. Software for CCTV Cameras
- b. Hardware specifications and ancillary equipment for CCTV Cameras

B. LPR Cameras

- a. Software for LPR Cameras
- b. Hardware specifications and ancillary equipment for LPR Cameras

C. FULLY FUNCTIONAL BACK OFFICE

- a. Software for CCTV & LPR computers and monitoring systems
- b. Hardware specifications of equipment for CCTV & LPR monitoring systems

D. SECURITY CLEARED PERSONNEL TO MONITOR CAMERAS 24/7

a. Sufficient qualified and security cleared personnel to monitor all cameras in the control room 24/7.

2. SCOPE OF WORKS

I. CCTV and LPR Surveillance Overview

Potential bidders are required to do their own assessment of the crime hotspots within Groblersdal and submit a proposal where the various cameras must be placed with specific surveillance objectives and functions. (This is subject to change for image enhancement).

II. Connectivity

Secured Optic Fibre connection is compulsory. Provision must be made by the prospective service provider for their own power supply. The provision of power supplies must ensure consistent power is provided 24 hours of the day and must be supplied, secured and maintained by the service provider.

III. Description of the License Plate Recognition camera locations:

- LPR01, LPR02, LPR03, LPR04, LPR05, LPR06, LPR07 & LPR08 The proposed (8) eight x LPR (License Plate Recognition) camera sites are at the four entrances to the town. The cameras at each entrance must capture all vehicles entering and exiting the town and determine direction of travel. (Only entrance & exits routes)
- SUR001, SUR002 & SUR003 There are three (3) cameras proposed to be installed in the CBD (Central Business District) of Groblersdal town. These are high resolution PTZ cameras with 360° viewing capabilities. Reason for higher specification is to have the ability to easily capture detailed information of all vehicles, pedestrians passing through and conduct suitable surveillance on the intersection and direct vicinity.

A. CAMERA REQUIREMENTS

I. CCTV Cameras

- Minimum specification of the cameras should be IP, alternatively if analogue is proposed, a motivation as to why and specifically taking into account the media conversion and requirements.
- Cameras must be PoE or 12V powered.
- Specific camera lenses is specified in "Hardware Specifications".
- LPR cameras where mentioned must show a confidence level of 85% > during all weather conditions and throughout the day and night time as well as have the ability to feed into Microsoft Sequel or Microsoft Access database structures. Further information on this will be clarified closer to the time with the nominated provider/s.
 - ➤ LPR recognition device must have I/O triggers.
 - ➤ LPR recognition device must be able to sync with an international time server.
 - ➤ Cameras must have an on-board storage facility to be used to store footage in the event of a communications failure and to act as a secondary backup. LPR off-line back-up must be able to send the backlog through to LPR software when communication resumes.
 - > Must be able to either view LPR cameras live and or recognition snapshots as and when required.
 - ➤ On-board IR for PTZ must be able to identify an object up to 150 meters.
 - Cameras must have dual streaming capabilities.

II. Camera mounting

- Cameras will be mounted on specific poles (as required by the Manager: Public Safety) at different locations.
- Camera height is important. Cameras must not be mounted lower than 3 meters from the ground.
- Cameras to be mounted using correct and compliant mounts onto poles. In situations where custom mounts are used, these are to be manufactured in a robust way which matches the IP 56 / IP 66 rating of the camera.
- Termination boxes can be used and mounted as well, they must comply with IP66/67. These will house equipment related to the functionality of the CCTV system.
- Power to the pole and camera will be required to be drawn from the nearest property or alternatively solar
 power where necessary. Please note that the successful bidder must make provision for cabling and providing
 the power to the cameras. This will be discussed in the information session.
- Minimum length of poles for the CCTV Cameras are 3.8 m x 100 mm x 100 mm x 5 mm Square tubing Galvanized Poles (unless other alternative poles are provided and approved by the Manager: Public Safety within the SANS 0400 specifications) mounted on a base plate according to the minimum requirements and specifications of the Municipality. One (1) pole for each CCTV camera planted at the identified area.
- Minimum length of poles for the PTZ Cameras are 6 m x 150 mm x 150 mm x 5 mm Square tubing Galvanized Poles (unless other alternative poles are provided and approved by the Manager: Public Safety within the SANS 0400 specifications) planted according to the minimum requirements and specifications of the Municipality. One (1) pole for each PTZ camera planted at the identified area
