## **PUBLIC NOTICE:MUNICIPALITY ANNOUNCES MEASURES TO DISRUPT THE CHAIN OF SPREAD OF COVID-19.**

The Elias Motsoaledi Local Municipality announces the following measures to disrupt the chain in transmission of COVID-19 (Coronavirus disease) thereby protecting community members and the staff from COVID-19:

1. Non-emergency employees, including interns and experiential trainees shall work from home until further notice with effect from Tuesday, 24<sup>th</sup> March 2020.
2. Only customers / service recipients of emergency services will receive municipal services. The emergency services include the:
  - ❖ disaster management services,
  - ❖ traffic services as provided by the traffic officers;
  - ❖ municipal security services;
  - ❖ Funeral related services and the likes.
3. The customers' details (Names, ID Numbers, Contacts and physical address) will need to be furnished Where necessary.
4. All the other non-emergency municipal services are suspended until further notice.

5. Customers are encouraged to make payments of the municipal services online.
6. No re-claimers and private individuals will be allowed to access the landfill site until further notice.
7. No visitors shall be allowed in the municipality.
8. Everyone, the employees and members of the public are reminded to sanitise their hands as frequently as possible with hands sanitisers or soap and water for at least twenty (20) seconds.
9. Everyone is strongly encouraged to follow the prescribed hygiene steps and those experiencing COVID-19 infection symptoms, should report these to the relevant authorities and medical practitioners, self-isolate and request to be tested.
10. This is part of an overall public health strategy to curb the spread of COVID-19 and protect both the employees and members of the municipal community from this pandemic.
